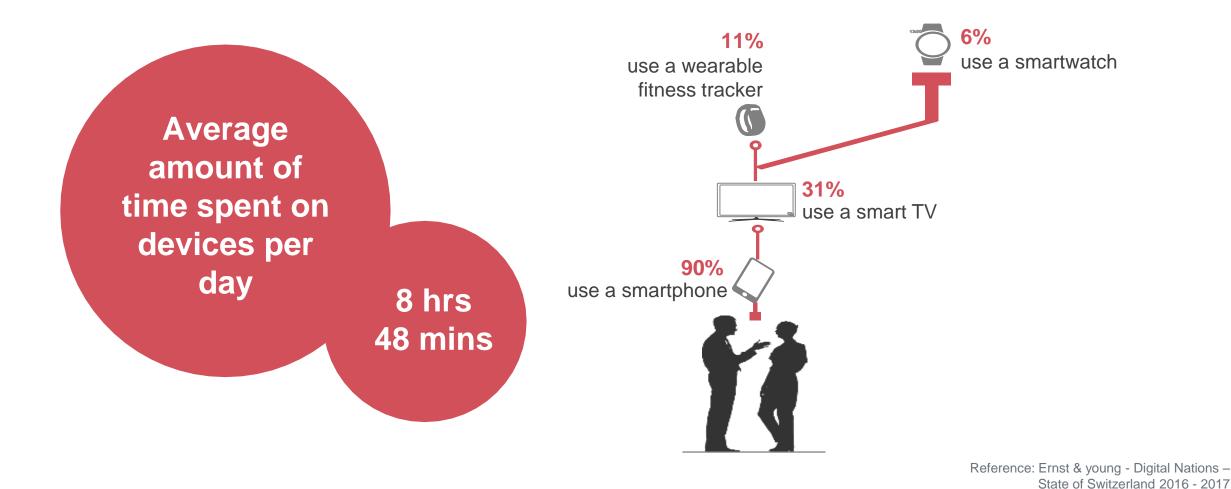

Customers will shop in augmented reality by 2020



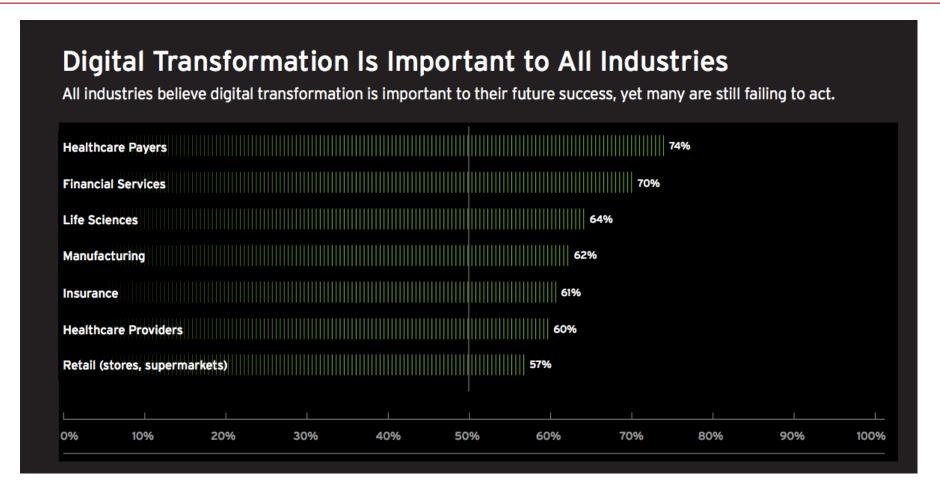

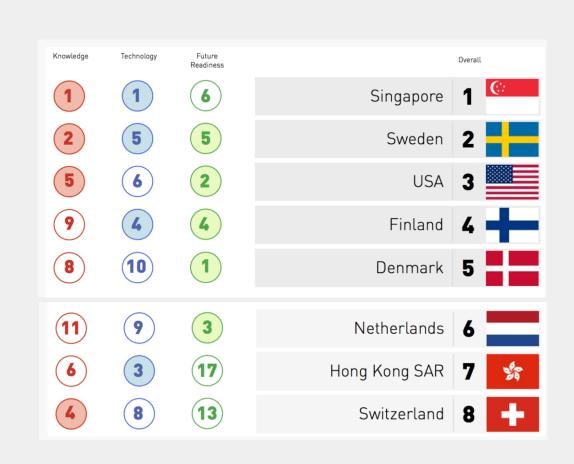


BUT: NO REASON TO REST ON OUR DIGITAL LAURELS...
